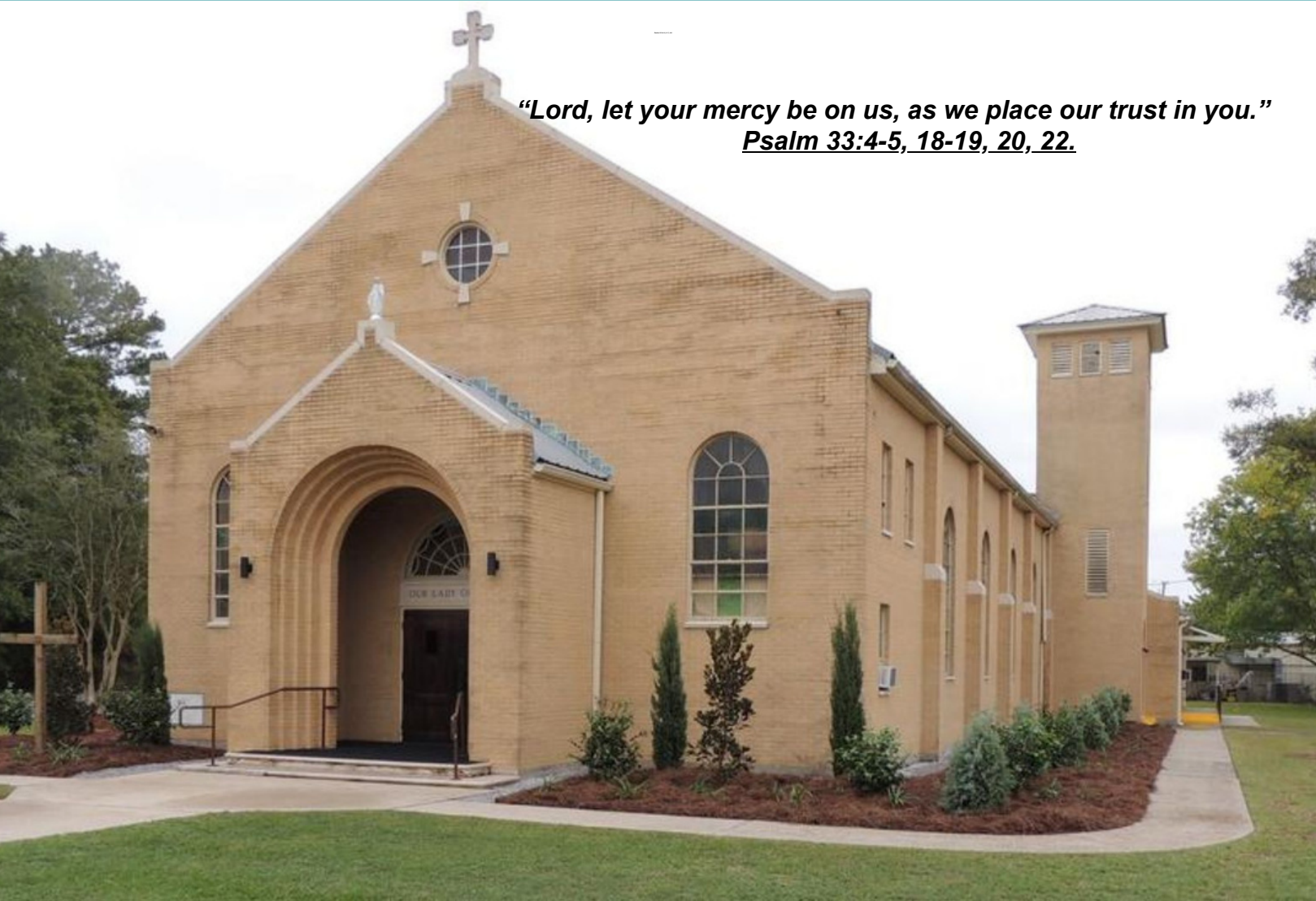

Second Week of Lent: Repentance

As we start our second week of Lent, we focus on a key aspect of spiritual growth: **repentance**. Through repentance, we are called to turn away from sin and return to God, embarking on a journey of transformation and renewal. The call to repentance echoes loudly and clearly throughout the Old and New Testaments. In the Hebrew scriptures, the word “repent” often translates to “turn” or “return”. It embodies the idea of turning away from evil and embracing the good: **“Repent! Turn from your idols and renounce all your detestable practices!” (Ezekiel 14:6)**
